Julie Silas is a Senior Directing Attorney at Homebase, with more than twenty-five years' experience working as an advocate and thought partner with and on behalf of low-income communities. At Homebase, she works with city, county, and nonprofit organizations across the country to adopt best practices; engage in homelessness strategic planning; conduct Continuum of Care (CoC) assessments; facilitate development of HOME-ARP Allocation Plans; lead consumer focus groups and other stakeholder outreach; and undertake data analysis. She is an expert on cross-sector coordination between health and homeless systems of care and has presented and written about successful cross-system and cross-agency data sharing to improve coordination and collaboration between health and homeless systems.

Presentation Overview

Medi-Cal now requires individuals to renew their eligibility annually. This means that around 16 million Californians will need to go through the renewal process in the next year. It is estimated that 1.5 million current members may lose their coverage due to procedural reasons. Homebase is launching a Medi-Cal renewals campaign to help homeless individuals maintain their coverage. Homebase is already collaborating with communities and has seen positive results through on-site renewal events, providing mailing addresses, and outreach efforts to those living in the streets.
