1941: Charles Brouse, civic leader and banker, establishes the Riverside Distribution Committee to provide scholarships.

1979: Our name changes to The Riverside Foundation and expands focus to health, human services, civic benefit programs, arts and culture.

2000: Our geographic service region expands and the name changes to The Community Foundation with a new tag line.



2019: The Foundation officially changes to Inland Empire Community Foundation (IECF), refreshing its brand to grow local giving, amplify our story and inspire collaboration in the IE.

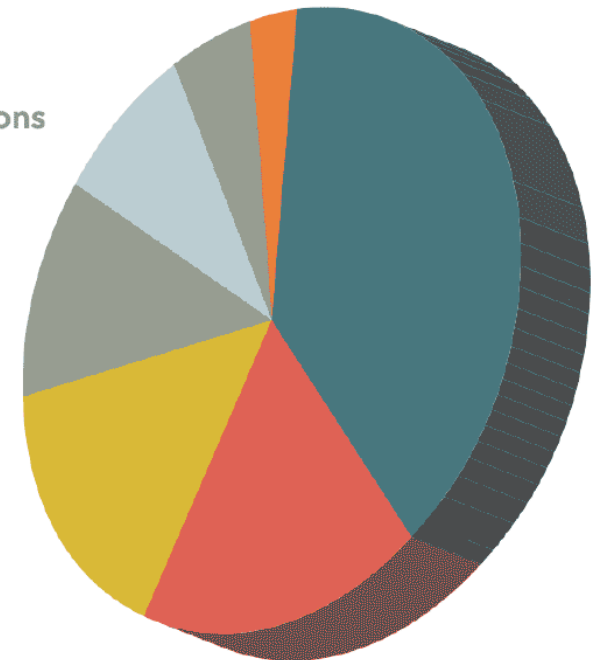

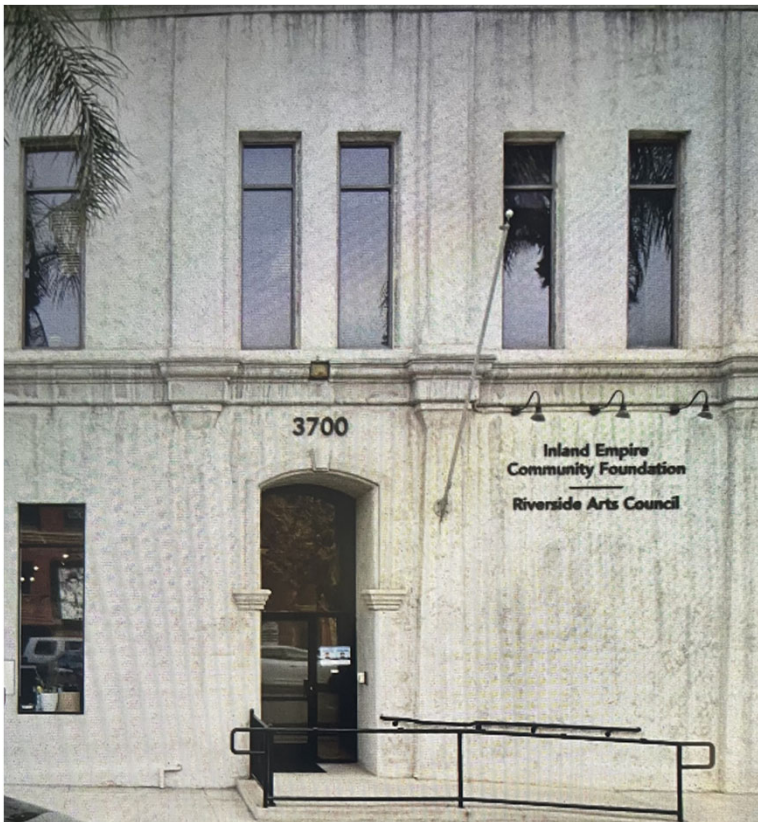
