Overview

This competitive grant opportunity is specifically designed for eligible nonprofit agencies, located in the 2nd Supervisorial District, that have suffered a negative financial impact related to the Covid-19 pandemic in Riverside County.

Funding provided through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA)

Timeline

Opens: April 15th

Closes: May 15th

We anticipate announcements by the end of June with initial disbursements in July.



Eligible Organizations

- ✓ 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(19)
- ✓ Serving in Riverside County District 2
- ✓ In operation before 1/1/2020
- ✓ Be an Impacted Nonprofit
 1. Located in [Qualified Census Tract](#) (QCT)
 - OR
 2. Can Demonstrate Financial Impact
- ✓ Spend in Compliance with SLFRF Final Rule
- ✓ In good standing (including Attorney General's Office [DOJ](#) & Secretary of State [SOS](#))
- ✓ Did NOT receive RCNAF Round 1 Funding



Grant Awards

Up to \$150,000 per organization.

Reporting

Quarterly Narrative & Expenditure Reports will be required.

Eligible Expenses

- ✓ Items necessary to improve organizational success, resiliency, and/or capacity
- ✓ General Operating Expenses
- ✓ Revenue Loss (Unrecouped)
- ✓ Increased Costs (Unrecouped)
- ✓ Other items not listed as ineligible may be deemed eligible on a case-by-case basis

Ineligible Expenses

- ☹️ No Lobbying, Political, or Fundraising Efforts
- ☹️ No Compensation for Officers / Bonuses
- ☹️ No Pension Funds / Liabilities
- ☹️ No Rainy-Day Funds / Financial Reserves
- ☹️ No Debt Services / Settlements / Judgements
- ☹️ No Inherently Religious Activities
- ☹️ No expenses that have already been covered by another source of funding (duplication of benefits)
- ☹️ No projects that conflict with or contravene with the purpose of ARPA/SLFRF
- ☹️ Expenses that do not serve RivCo Residents

*** Any other items disallowed by the SLFRF Final Rule



Required Documents

1) Proof of Non-Profit Status

- a. IRS Determination Letter
- b. Proof of Registration & Active Status with CA Attorney General's Office ([DOJ website](#))

2) Proof of Covid Baseline Info

- a. Preferred: IRS Form 990 for FY2019 and/or FY2020
- b. Alternative: Comparable Financial Statements for FY2019 and/or FY2020

3) Proof of Covid Financial Impact

- a. Preferred: IRS Form 990 for FY2021, FY2022 and/or FY2023
- b. Alternative: Comparable Financial Statements for FY2021, FY2022, and/or FY2023

4) Board of Directors Roster

List of your Board of Directors / Board Members and company affiliations

5) Other Verification Documents (as needed)

Ex: Proof of Service in District 2, Proof of QCT Location, etc.

Is your organization currently registered as a 501(c)3 or 501(c)19? *

Does your organization serve Riverside County District 2? *

You are able to provide a Riverside County service address (main office, satellite office, partner site, or pop-up event) and proof of services at that address

If you are a faith-based organization, do you provide community social services programs to the public, that are clearly separate from your inherently religious activities? *

Was your organization in operation prior to 1/1/2020? *

You are able to provide an IRS Determination letter dated prior to 2020
