- 1.0** This addendum is considered to be part of the Request for Proposal (RFP). All other terms of the RFP remain unchanged and in effect. This addendum is intended to provide additional information and/or to change requirements in the above referenced RFP. Any information contained herein will be considered part of the RFP and as such will be used in the evaluation of the bid responses. **Attention all potential bidders, if you have already submitted your proposal prior to the bid closing date, please review this addendum and re-submit your bid response, should this addendum modify your initial bid response.**
- 2.0** Section 5. HUD’s STRATEGIC PLANNING GOALS AND HOMELESS POLICY PRIORITIES is amended to the following:
- “5. HUD’S GOALS AND OBJECTIVES**
- HUD has the following goals for this competition:
- (1) ***Increasing Supportive Housing for People with Disabilities.*** HUD is seeking applications for PSH projects that are dedicated to serving individuals with a disability, particularly elderly individuals (over age 62). Unlike Transitional Housing projects designed to facilitate moving on to self-sufficiency, HUD encourages PSH resources to be reserved and prioritized for individuals likely to have indefinite support needs who the CoC determines are unlikely to regain self-sufficiency. Given the significant supply of existing PSH across the nation and the underutilization of interim and Transitional Housing solutions; HUD is seeking PSH projects that meet targeted needs in communities, unmet by existing PSH.
 - (2) ***Partnering with Housing, Health, and Service Agencies. Partnering with Housing, Health, and Social Service Organizations.*** HUD encourages CoCs to apply for PSH projects that coordinate with housing, healthcare, and social service organizations (e.g. primary healthcare, substance-use disorder treatment, mental health treatment, and other services) within the PSH project.
 - (3) ***Engaging Participants in Services and Community.*** HUD is seeking PSH projects that engage participants in services designed to assist them in living independently (i.e., case management, life skills, on-site work or volunteer opportunities, etc.). Projects should facilitate community building among participants.”
- 3.0** Section 10. REPORTING is amended to correct the numbering of the subparagraphs to begin with “1” instead of “4.”
- 4.0** Section 10 REPORTING, paragraph 5, is amended to the following:

- “2. Race, Ethnicity and Other Data Reporting: HUD requires recipients that provide HUD-funded program benefits to individuals or families to report data on the race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, disability, and family characteristics of persons and households who are applicants for, participants in, or beneficiaries or potential beneficiaries of HUD programs. Each recipient shall keep such records and submit to the Department timely, complete, and accurate compliance reports at such times, and in such form and containing such information, as the Department may determine to be necessary to enable it to ascertain whether the recipient has complied or is complying with 24 CFR parts 1 and 121. In general, recipients should have available for the Department data showing the demographics of beneficiaries of Federally-assisted programs. HUD will collect this information through the Homelessness Data Exchange (HDX) based on HMIS data submitted by CoCs.”

5.0 Section 10 REPORTING, paragraph 6, is amended to change the title to the following:

- “6. Annual Performance Report (APR)”
