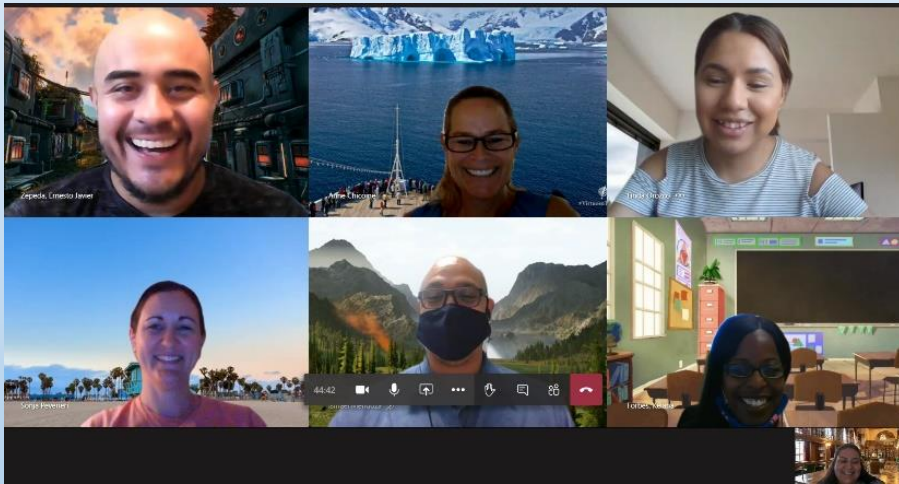
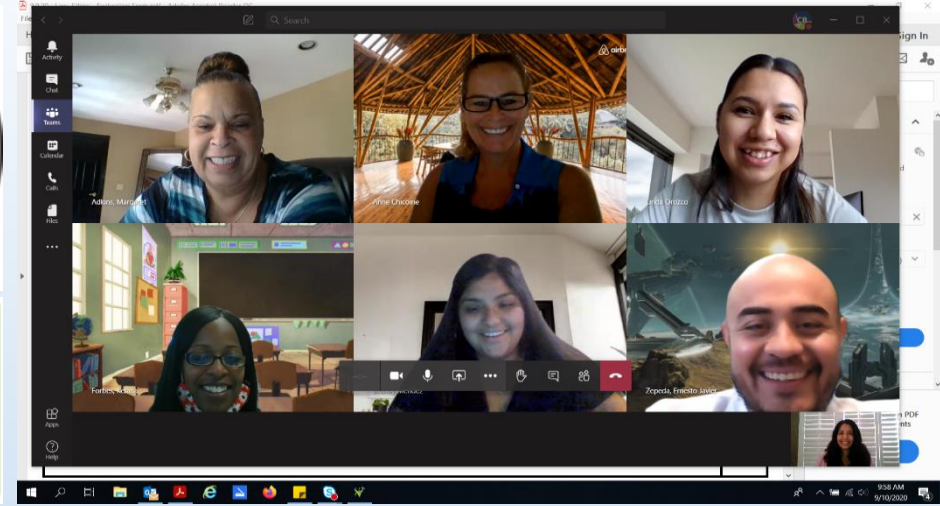

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DPSS/CalWORKs

- The California Work Opportunity and Responsibility for Kids (CalWORKs) is a public assistance program that gives cash assistance and services to eligible needy California families.
- If a family has little or no cash and needs housing, food, utilities, clothing or medical care, they may be eligible to receive immediate short-term help.
- Cash assistance and services may be available for:
 - Families that have a child(ren) in the home who has been deprived of parental support or care because of the absence, disability or death of either parent.
 - Families with a child(ren) when both parents are in the home, but the primary earner is unemployed.
 - Needy caretaker relatives of a foster child(ren).


*Other eligibility requirements include an applicant's citizenship, age, income, resources, assets and other factors.

*The monthly amount of cash assistance a family can receive depends on a number of reasons, including the number of people who are eligible, any special needs of those eligible people, the amount of income they receive, and the value of their property (vehicles, checking accounts, etc.)

Family Stabilization Services (FSS) and Housing Support Program (HSP)

- The FSS program provides intensive case management and services designed to ensure a basic level of stability and barrier removal within a family to achieve full participation in WTW activities.
- The HSP offers homeless CalWORKs Assistance Units (AU) assistance in obtaining temporary, permanent and stable housing.
- The HSP is administered by FSS Employment Services Counselors (ESC) with support from CalWORKs, Welfare-to-Work (WTW), the Riverside University Health Systems Behavioral Health (RUHS-BH) Advocates, and partnering community housing support agencies through the Housing Authority, contracted Rapid Rehousing vendors and the Continuum of Care (CoC).

- Customer was approved for 16 nights. FSS intake was completed by Ernesto Zepeda on 6.16.2020.



August 2020

- Customer informed staff of unsafe living arrangements and needed to move out.
- Ernesto supported customer with the FSS/HSP 14 night voucher.



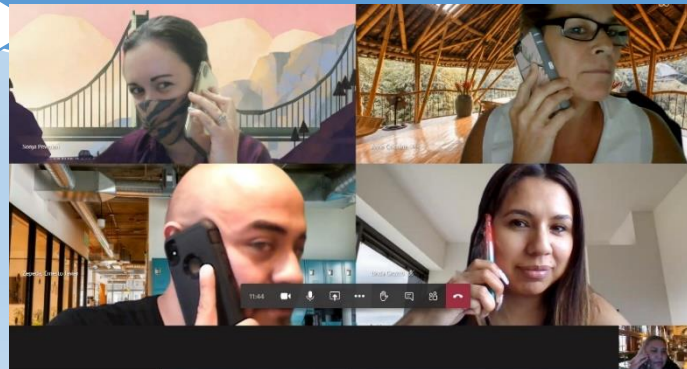
August 2020

- Customer filled out the Project Room Key packet.



August 2020

- Jovan Zebrowski secured an extension for three days with FSS.
- Customer was able to check in with dogs.



August 2020

- Customer was approved for a rental.
- Supervisor Keiana Forbes was informed that the unit was rented out and another available unit would be available soon.



August 2020

- Customer received an extension from Project Room Key for an additional 11 nights.



August 2020

- Customer went to go see a studio rental.
- Customer liked the studio Ernesto reached out to the rental property manager and sent the RUA packet to be processed.
- Inspection scheduled.



September 2020

- Kimberlee Samberson from HHOPE was contacted to explore HHOPE housing assistance.
- Kimberlee confirmed with Project Room Key that customer's hotel stay would be extended.

September 2020

- Ernesto Zepeda & Keiana Forbes were able to get a refrigerator delivered before inspection.
- The inspection required a re-inspection, repairs were completed.
- The family received the keys on 9.9.2020.
