Health Homes Program (HHP)



HHP Overview

Comprehensive care management with certain health conditions and criteria



Eligibility Requirements

One (1) Chronic Condition

☐ 2 or more in this category

- Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease
- Diabetes
- Traumatic brain injury
- Chronic or congestive heart failure
- Coronary artery disease
- Chronic liver disease
- Dementia
- Substance use disorders

OR

- ☐ Major depression disorders
- ☐ Bipolar disorder
- ☐ Psychotic disorders (including schizophrenia)

OR

☐ Hypertension & 1

- Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease
- Diabetes
- Coronary artery disease
- Chronic or congestive heart failure

OR

- ☐ Asthma

AND

One (1) Acuity/complexity criteria

- ☐ 3+ of the HHP eligible chronic conditions

OR

- ☐ 1 inpatient stay in previous 12 months

OR

- ☐ 3+ Emergency Department (ED) visits in previous 12 months

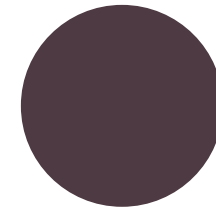

Behavioral Health Care Manager

- Assist Member to reach their mental health recovery goals
- Conduct & review mental health assessment
- Link Member to rehabilitation & support services



Care Coordinator

- Find Doctors
- Appointments
- Transportation for health visits
- Coordinate follow-up services after Member leaves Hospital



Community Health Worker

- Help Member connect and apply to community services:
 - Housing Programs
 - Vocational Programs
 - Accompaniment
 - Legal / Advocacy Services

- Get follow-up services after you leave the hospital
- Manage all your medicines
