Local Board Update

- The Riverside County EFSP Local Board allocated a total of \$2,325,760 this year in Phase 37 and Phase CARES funding to both returning and new agencies to provide food, shelter and homeless prevention services in Riverside County.
- On June 10th, the board voted to extend the Phase 37/CARES Spending Period to May 31, 2021. This extension allows for agencies that were awarded in both phases to have additional time to spend their award and provides more time to determine award eligibility for Phase 38.
- The Phase 38 application process will begin in March of 2021.

Local Recipient Organization (LRO) Update

- Second Payment/Interim Payment Requests: Some LROs have already begun requesting their second payment for Phase 37/CARES. Remember to have your required spreadsheets prepared to submit to the Local Board Contact upon request of your second payment. Interim Payment spreadsheets should reflect that the first half of your entire award is spent.
- Technical Assistance Office Hours Now Available: New and returning LROs can now request technical assistance for help with understanding the reporting requirements and documentation procedures for EFSP funding. A one-hour technical assistance session will be provided via web conference at the request of the LRO. Available dates and times are listed on the bottom of the next page.
