## The information below is required by National for Closeouts.

	Landlord or Lender Verification form  *Must state that the payment will guarantee residency for an additional 30 days. Payment is limited to one-month's rent/mortgage (Principal and Interest only) not to exceed \$1,000.00  ☐ Current complete Rental/Lease Agreement or Mortgage Statement providing a breakdown of the principal and interest and/or the escrow amount
	Copy of canceled checks (front and back), copy of uncanceled fronts of checks and bank statement or check images included in bank statements are accepted *Please indicate which portion is EFSP and which portion is Other Funds, to equal the entire amount of the check. *EFSP portion cannot be over \$1,000.00 or one month's rent
